For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling. My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.

Dear Friends,

There is good news to be told that can only be proclaimed by those whose heart has been renewed and restored by the blessed Holy Spirit. This gospel of good news is not a message that originated in the heart of human beings. This message came down from heaven and lifts believers up into a kingdom prepared for them that was planned and purposed before the creation of Adam and Eve. When the intent of the gospel is misinterpreted or altered it becomes a distorted message of error and corruption.

The message of the cross achieving salvation and redemption, originated in the heart of God before the foundation of the world.

The TRUTH that the Lamb of God was the one and only way of salvation, sanctification and redemption did not begin in the doctrines and teachings of men. In the Father of creation's heart is a divine absolute intention of goodness and abundant grace to satisfy anyone's knowledge of the TRUTH. How can we as seekers know that we are abiding in the TRUTH?

The answer to this question is *"You can do nothing against the TRUTH, only for it"*. **2 Cor. 13: 8.**

Paul who wrote this scripture endorsed his belief with many other scriptures along with his companion apostles and prophets.

John 8: 32

Then you will know the TRUTH and the TRUTH will set you free. **John 8: 32.**

Ephesians 4: 15

Instead speaking the TRUTH in love, we will in all things grow up into Christ himself, who is the head.

Galatians 2: 5

We did not give into them for a moment, so that the TRUTH of the gospel would remain with you.

2 Timothy 2: 25

He must gently reprove those who oppose him, in the hope that God may grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the TRUTH.

1 Corinthians 13: 6

Love takes no pleasure in evil, but rejoices in the TRUTH.

1 John 3: 18

Little children, let us love not in word and speech, but in action and TRUTH.

Romans 1: 18

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the TRUTH by their wickedness.

1 John 1: 6

If we say we have fellowship with him yet walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the TRUTH.

1 Corinthians 4: 20

For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk, but power in the TRUTH.

Proverbs 12: 19

TRUTHFUL lips endure forever, but a lying tongue lasts only a moment.

Zechariah 8: 16

These are the things you must do, speak TRUTH to one another.

Psalms 119: 30

I have chosen the way of TRUTH: I have set your ordinances before me.

Isaiah 59: 14

So justice is turned away, and righteousness stands at a distance. For TRUTH has stumbled in the public square and honesty cannot enter.

Jeremiah 9: 3

"They bend their tongues like bows, lies prevail over TRUTH in the land. For they proceed from evil to evil, and they do not take ME into account" declares the Lord.

For century after century, naturally minded men have invented ways to distract the seeker from obtaining the TRUTH and living in the rest of God, which is the finished work of Christ upon the cross of Calvary. Sin, evil and all liars were defeated by the death of Christ and his resurrection

into life eternal. Jesus' cry on the cross "it is finished" is a declaration that the true believer can embrace with confidence and faith.

Doctrines and ritualistic practices of naturally minded men have stolen the power of the TRUTH and mixed it into a cauldron of jumbled anti-Christ and devilish works that are devoid of the power of the TRUTH.

Where then does the TRUTH abide and how can we restore the TRUTH into reality?

The answer is this! You can do nothing against the TRUTH, only for it.

The true believer willingly submits to the teaching of the Holy Spirit and obeys the gospel of Jesus Christ and lives by faith under the lordship of Jesus. Though they live in the world, they are not of the world.

Let us through the scriptures which have previously been brought to our attention, ask the Holy Spirit to consolidate their meanings and intention to our hearts and minds.

Firstly, we must receive the TRUTH from God alone, not through the teachings of men. Repent from dead works and die with Christ on Calvary forsaking all. We must love one another and live as one born anew under the reign and lordship of Jesus.

*Jesus answered, I am the way, the TRUTH and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. **John 14: 6.***

If we try to come some other way, we are thieves and robbers. Many are using other methods and ideas and are adding other things to the gospel of salvation, sanctification and redemption.

Well may they self-endorse their practices and deceive many, but they can do nothing against the TRUTH.

The TRUTH that is in Jesus will stand any attack, will endure every hardship, will repel any onslaught and will expose every lie and deception.

Many institutions that appear truthful because of their longevity, seem to escape the wrath and judgement of God, but false history will eventually be exposed in the light of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. Every institution has been ordained by God to keep us from destroying ourselves, but these institutions have been corrupted by evil men under Satan's power. The kingdom of God is the new way of living because it cannot be corrupted.

Some institutions and powers may seem formidable to an ongoing saint, yet this power does not give them legitimacy. Only the truth will remain forever. Thy word is truth. Every kingdom that is not submitted to the kingdom of God and the Lordship of Jesus, will be brought low and those captivated and deceived will be granted the choice of TRUTH that is in Jesus, but as the scripture says, many will keep their evil ways and follow Satan into the lake of fire.

How can we as mortals be sure that we abide in the TRUTH?

Well it goes back to the very beginning – before there was any creation – before there was any time – before there was any space. There was the Alpha and Omega – this was God who is the great "I Am". The One who before Abraham was "I Am". He was and is the cause and purpose of all things.

This great “I Am”, is the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. He is the omnipotent invisible God whom no man can see, the One whom Jesus declared and openly revealed. Jesus is the only One who came down from heaven to declare the Father’s glory.

Every other prophet or holy man throughout history promoted the thought that they heard the message from heaven and this message gave them the ability to ascend into heaven.

Jesus is the only being that said “he came down from heaven”, every other religion speaks Satan’s words “I will ascend into heaven and be like the Most High God”. This is the fundamental TRUTH of how you can know the TRUTH of what your belief is based on. Everyone wants to go to heaven, but no one wants to die! If you are not willing to die to this world and trust and believe in Jesus for eternal life, then your life is built upon a lie. The church as we know it is complicit in this deception and will eventually be shown to be the wolf in sheep’s clothing.

The death and dying of the old covenant and the new covenant are two different meanings of death. The old covenant saints were conscious of physical death or medical death, but were unsure of what happens after death. They referred to it as “returning to their fathers”. They knew about Enoch and Elijah having ascended to another realm and that evil Korah and his followers descended into the pit below the ground. The Pharisees and the Sadducees in Jesus’ days were of different haltering opinions. Jesus made it quite clear that he would raise Lazarus after his physical or medical death. It must be noted; the religious elite plotted to kill Lazarus and Jesus after Lazarus had been raised out from among the dead. Jesus is the resurrection and the life and has the power to bring the medically or physically dead to life again. The scriptures encourage us to fear him who can destroy both body and soul in hell. The new testament covenant meaning of death and dying does not refer to the physical or medical death of Romans 7: 2. The dying of the new covenant is a death and dying to all things that oppose the TRUTH of the great “I Am” that he is the giver of life eternal. All that pass through this world as pilgrims, must live by faith in the gospel of Jesus Christ. The dying that is required, is the dying to everything that opposes or adds additional requirements to receiving eternal life, rather than faith in Christ. Physical or medical death is not the teaching of the new testament as something to fear. The teaching of the new covenant in Christ is faith that overcomes the second death – the lake of fire. Those that overcome will not be hurt by the second death. This message was proclaimed to the believers in Smyrna who were being persecuted, but were faithful to the point of physical or medical death.

Revelation 2: 8-11

⁸ These are the words of him who is the First and the Last, who died and came to life again. ⁹ I know your afflictions and your poverty – yet you are rich! I know the slander of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. ¹⁰ Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison to test you, and you will suffer persecution for ten days. Be faithful even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life. ¹¹ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the called out ones. He who overcomes will not be hurt at all by the second death.

The apostles and disciples themselves did not have their physical deaths recorded in scripture (except Antipas), but it is implied in history that they were martyred for the faith. Yet in scripture, they encourage and write for the believers to die to this world and study to show

themselves approved unto God. They taught through the Holy Spirit to resist the praises and accolades of men. They were never to rebuild the rituals and practices that Christ destroyed, which naturally minded men count as God pleasing. They were to resist titles and honours that shone the light on their works and took the glory that belongs to Christ. This kingdom they lived in drew the challenges of physical and medical death, yet it was a kingdom of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. They knew that serving Christ in this manner was pleasing unto God and taught them that eternal life was knowing the Father and whom he sent.

The gospel has a fundamental truthful premise! This premise is a word of promise that the great “I Am”, is our Father who is a God of love revealed in Jesus Christ by acts of love - who saves, sanctifies and redeems that which is lost. This great God of all things came down out of heaven, humbled himself and took on our estate of poverty. He then lifted us out of death to create in us a new self in the image of his only begotten Son. This salvation is by grace and by grace alone.

As the Psalmist says in **Psalm 45: 4**.

*In your majesty, ride forth victoriously in behalf of TRUTH, humility and righteousness;
let your right hand display awesome deeds.*

The world and its religious leaders declared it was a righteous judgement to crucify Jesus. But heaven declared that through the cross and resurrection from death to life that it was finished, and every deception and falsehood against the truth was now impotent. The scripture declares there will be no other sign given but the cross.

What is the fundamental TRUTH that underpins every thought intention and purpose of the gospel? It is, that, the great “I Am” who is a person who humbled himself and entered our low estate as a person to save, sanctify and redeem persons who were trapped eternally in the condemnation of trespasses and sins. There is now no condemnation to those who live in Christ Jesus who walk not after the flesh but after the Spirit.

When this fundamental TRUTH is violated error develops and hearts and minds are distorted to follow the stranger.

Jesus said *“My sheep hear my voice and a stranger they will not follow”*. **John 10**.

The fundamental TRUTH of the gospel is:

- It is God who saves
- Salvation is of the Lord
- Man cannot redeem or save
- What is impossible with man is possible with God
- You were not the one who ordained how salvation would be accomplished
- It was God the great “I Am” who declared that it would be *“Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit”*.
- The great “I Am” declared before anything was created that it would be a Lamb slain that would take away the sin of the world – salvation was accomplished by Christ Jesus on Calvary, not through man’s works, but by belief in Christ’s work. *“This is the work of God: to believe in the One he has sent”*. **John 14: 6**. Belief comes by revelation of TRUTH that comes from God.

This revelation is what underpins every idea that comes down out of heaven. The word that comes from heaven refers to an event, an act that discloses the hidden and unseen great “I Am” – who acts. This act culminates in the revealing of the Word becoming flesh and that God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself through the death and resurrection of the Lamb of God.

God has now made Lord and Christ this Jesus whom you crucified – repent – yes we are all complicit in the crucifixion of Christ. The new testament is declaring that it is the great “I Am” who has taken the road of humility and meekness and lowered himself to condescend to the lowest form of judgement. Jesus Christ not only bore the judgement meant for us, he took the penalty that justice demanded for our sin. By his death we are now set free.

Revelation is not a gift to superior individuals that exalts them above fellow mortals, rather it is the overwhelming condemnation that the Messiah God came into the world and was crucified by us all. We are saved by the grace of the Master’s plan, not by what we think the plan must be. We must repent.

The gospel is the declaration by the Almighty before creation began, which declared in an unbreakable covenant that if creation did fall into sin and rebellion he would redeem it. The great “I Am” would condescend to be humiliated and scorned to bring what was fallen, back to glory and into a new creation that would never fall again.

This is the gospel – this gospel is not our endeavours but it is the humiliation of a loving heavenly Father who would lay down everything he loved to save, sanctify and redeem what was lost. Let us repent and believe the gospel is the TRUTH that God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself and is now not holding our sins against us.

He laid down his life for us, and we now lay down what we think is the reality the world offers and we are crucified to the world and the world is crucified to us. We now live by faith and not by sight under the lordship of Jesus Christ in the kingdom of God and live as servants and ambassadors for Christ. We are saved by the grace of God and our names are written in the Lamb’s book of life.

We cannot save one soul, but we declare the One who can save all souls.

Jesus is the Way, the TRUTH and the Life.
